

In keeping with the Icelandic way of thinking, our focus is not on theory, but on immersion, experience, experimentation, and results.

WHAT YOU CAN TAKE AWAY

There is no ready-made solution for your individual innovative ability—but you can develop your own blueprint and shape the innovation process yourself.

We know that every context requires tailor-made solutions. That's why we work together to develop skills, perspectives, and approaches that will help you overcome daily innovation hurdles.

On each day of the course, we provide space for you to apply what you have learned directly to your own challenges. We will keep the course days agile in the Icelandic style and adapt them to the respective situations on site.

Our aim is not to teach in an abstract way, but to provide you with concrete support for your personal challenges. To this end, you will take away numerous examples, inspirations, and food for thought from Icelandic culture and the surrounding environment that will help you to question blockages and develop new perspectives.

By the way: We take advantage of the Icelandic time difference (-2 hours) to organize the seminar days so that you have enough time before the seminar starts to take care of your professional or everyday life in Germany or simply have free time in Reykjavík.


HOTELBUCHUNG & WORKSHOP-ORT
